

X-ray imaging Viewer for XP SuperZero Introducing the 2025 revised version


We would like to introduce the changes made to the 2025 revised edition of X-View, the viewing software for the X-ray CMOS camera X-Point Super Zero.

Improved operability No.1



Max value control




Improved operability No.2


- ▶ Previous version starts from full screen. But the 1936(H) x 1216(V) image will not fit and you will not know where you are looking, so we have made it start from 1/2 screen - 968(H) x 608(V). You can observe the entire field of view from the initial screen.






New feature added: Edge Enhance


- ▶ Added Edge Enhance function. In case you checked the checkbox, the default strength 5 will be set. You can set the strength between 1 and 9.

Overview of X-ray Imaging Viewer

- ▶ X-View is an image viewer for our X-ray CMOS camera handling 8-bit monochrome image. Since the X-ray power, sample, and other environments change during demonstrations, we designed it so that users can intuitively operate it while checking the images.
